PROGRAM OVERVIEW: VETERAN HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (VHIP)

The Veteran Home Improvement Program (VHIP) is a charitable initiative operated by Non-Profit Construction Corporation (NPC), CSLB #1125441, EIN 99-1958124. The program provides free home repairs, accessibility modifications, and housing support services to eligible U.S. military veterans. VHIP is funded through revenue-generating on-the-job training construction projects, with all proceeds reinvested into veteran housing rehabilitation.

Key Operational Features

- Eligibility Verification: All applicants must submit DD-214 documentation. Services are available to veterans regardless of disability status.**
- Service Scope: Includes exterior/interior repairs, disaster recovery construction, accessibility retrofits, and pathways to homeownership via modular/manufactured housing.**
- Participation Clause: Veterans who are physically and mentally able are encouraged to attend at least three veteran organization events (e.g., VFW Hall meetings, community service projects). Veterans may not fulfill participation requirements through their own VHIP project.**
- Funding Source: VHIP is sustained by NPC's licensed construction operations. Materials, labor, and contractor services are allocated at no cost to the veteran.**

NPC encourages veterans to receive services without hesitation or guilt. Participation in community events is a way for our veterans to build bonds and gain an understanding of further resources available to them in our community, but it is not a requirement for receiving assistance. The program is structured to ensure dignity, support, and empowerment for every veteran served.
